**G.S.R.176** .-In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9B, sub-section (4) of section 15 and section 15A of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act No. 67 of 1957), the State Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan District Mineral Foundation Trust Rules, 2016, namely:-

**1. Short title and commencement.-** (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan District Mineral Foundation Trust (Amendment) Rules, 2020.  
(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Amendment of rule 5.-** The existing sub-rule (1) of rule 5 of the Rajasthan District Mineral Foundation Trust Rules, 2016, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(1) The District Mineral Foundation Trust constituted for each district of the state under section 9B of the Act shall consist of the following trustees, namely:

**3. Insertion of new rule 13A.**-After the existing rule 13 and before the existing rule 14 of the said rules, the following new rule 13A shall be inserted, namely:-

**“13A. Payment of Interest.**- If any mineral concession holder fails to pay the contribution to the Fund as specified in sub-rule (1) of rule 13, he shall be liable to pay interest,-

- (i) in case of major minerals, as prescribed in the Minerals (Other than Atomic and **Hydrocarbon** Energy Minerals) Concession Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time; and
- (ii) in case of minor minerals, as prescribed in the Rajasthan Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2017, as amended from time to time.”

**4. Amendment of rule 15.**- In rule 15 of the said rules,-

- (i) in sub-clause (C) of clause (II) of sub-rule (2), for the existing expression " as far as possible, in consultation with local/elected representatives of gram sabha”, the expression "as per the provisions of the Pneumoconiosis policy, 2019 of the State Government, as amended from time to time." shall be substituted;
- (ii) in sub-clause (D) of clause (II) of sub-rule (2), for the existing expression “the Rajasthan Environment and Health Administrative Board”, the expression “ the Pneumoconiosis policy, 2019 of the State Government.” shall be substituted;
- (iii) in sub-clause (A) of clause (i) of sub-rule (3), for the existing expression “at least sixty percentage of the fund to be utilized under these heads:”, the expression “at least sixty percentage of the fund to be utilized under these heads but at least fifty percent of the above shall be utilized for works specified in item (a), (c), (d) and (e).” shall be substituted;
- (iv) in item (a) of sub-clause (A) of clause (i) of sub-rule (3), for the existing expression “piped water supply system”, the expression “piped water supply system and drinking water facility in government recognized and duly registered cow shelters” shall be substituted;
- (v) in para (ii) of item (c) of sub-clause (A) of clause (i) of sub-rule (3), for the existing expression “regular health check-up camps”, the expression “regular health check-up camps, silicosis checkup/awareness camps, safety helmet, safety shoes and other safety equipment’s distribution camps” shall be substituted;
- (vi) in item (d) of sub-clause (A) of clause (i) of sub-rule (3), for the existing expression “school buildings”, the expression “Government school buildings and Government college buildings” shall be substituted; and
- (vii) after the existing sub-rule (6), the following new sub-rules (7) and (8) shall be added, namely: -

“(7) There shall be a fund at the state level to be known as State Mineral Fund. The State Mineral Fund shall be maintained at the Directorate of Mines and Geology, Rajasthan, Udaipur. The State Mineral Fund shall be utilized for undertaking projects/works related to the development of the directly or indirectly affected mining areas of any district or projects/works which falls under the jurisdiction of multiple districts and for supplementing the public welfare schemes of the State Government and Central Government which are in conformity with the objective of these rules by the State Level Empowered Committee specified in sub-clause (C) of Clause (II) of sub-rule (3) of this rule. The Accounts of the State Mineral Fund shall be audited every year by the Accountant General Rajasthan. Every district mineral foundation trust shall transfer to the State Mineral Fund,-

- (i) out of unutilized fund available with the district mineral foundation trust as on 01.04.2020, as specified in the table A given below:-

**Explanation:** For the purpose of this clause unutilized fund means the balance trust fund available after excluding the actual expenditure and amount for which financial sanctions have been issued prior to 01.04.2020; and

- (ii) for the year 2020-21 and thereafter for each year, as specified in the table B given below:-

- (8) Transfers of the fund specified under,-

- (i) clause (i) of sub-rule (7) to the State Mineral Fund shall be made within fifteen days from the date of commencement of the Rajasthan District Mineral Foundation Trust (Amendment) Rules, 2020; and
- (ii) clause (ii) of sub-rule (7) to the State Mineral Fund shall be made from the month in which Trust is liable for transfer of fund latest by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the next month:

Provided that the installments for the month of April, May and June, 2020, if liable for transfer, shall be transferred upto 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2020."
