MINUTES OF PRE-NIT MEET HELD ON 07th DECEMBER, 2021

The Pre-NIT meet regarding e-auction of 33 major mineral blocks was held on 07th December, 2021 in the Conference Hall of Directorate, Department of Mines and Geology under the chairmanship of Dr. Kunj Bihari Pandya _{IAS} Director, Mines and Geology Department. Officers of DMGR, representatives from various companies were present in the meeting (List of participants annexed).

- Shri Mahesh Mathur, Additional Director Mines (HQ) welcomed the stakeholders attending the Pre-NIT meet.
- 2. He conveyed to the bidders that Rajasthan State is endowed with variety of minerals of which blocks are under preparation. He also conveyed that Rajasthan State has successfully auctioned eight blocks of limestone till date after commencement of MMDR Amendment Act, 2015 and State has set out an ambitious target of putting 33 blocks for auction in F.Y. 2021-22.
- 3. He also informed that in addition to these 33 blocks State is also preparing limestone blocks in Jaisalmer, Chittorgarh and Nagaur district besides blocks handed over by GSI of base metal, nickel, platinum and potash for auction in future.
- 4. The welcome address was followed by detailed presentation by concerned Additional Director Geology on above mentioned 33 blocks.
- 5. After the presentation the following queries were raised by the stakeholders:-

1.	The stakeholder requested to provide presentation to them	The presentation will be uploaded on departmental website.
2.	The stakeholder requested that a customer support group may be created to help them out about the queries related to auction of blocks.	Sh. Anil Verma, Addl. Director Geology, OIC (Bidding Cell – Major), Sh. D.P. Gaur, Suptdg. Mining Engineer (HQ-II), Sh. S.K. Minda, Suptdg. Geologist (HQ), may be contacted in case of any issue related to auction of blocks.
3.	The stakeholder requested that the affidavit of all directors of the company has been mandatory with Technical Bid by Rajasthan State during the auction of block in 15 days after declaration of preferred bidder while in other States, only the affidavit from the authorized signatory is being taken. They requested that like other State only the affidavit of authorized signatory may be taken with technical bid.	The affidavits of all directors are required to observe the compliance of section 6(3) of the Act. Further, the stakeholders were assured that the applicability of affidavit of all directors of the company in light of this said section may be vetted by the legal section of DMG Rajasthan and action will be taken accordingly.
4.	The stakeholders requested that the bank guarantee submitted by the preferred bidder may be returned once he submits the performance security.	The said provision has already been incorporated by DMGR in the tender document.

5.	The stakeholder requested that they may be given more time to submit the technical bid for a block during the auction process.	There is duration of 35 days between the floating of NIT and submission of technical bid which is sufficient for preparation of documents desired for auction of block.
6.	The stakeholder requested that the 10(A)2(B) blocks which are in litigation may not be proposed for auction by the State as it will lead to more litigation when third party rights are created.	The 10(A)2(B) blocks on which stay has been granted by Hon'ble court are not being proposed for auction by the State while the other 10(A)2(B) blocks on which there is not any stay granted are being proposed for auction by the State.
7.	The stakeholders requested that the jamabandi will also be provided with the tender document of the block.	The jamabandi is available on apnakhata.com and one may download from there if they needs it.
8.	The stakeholders requested that to whom the performance security is to be addressed may be mentioned in the tender document.	The performance security is to be addressed in favour of concerned AME/ME and same has been incorporated in the tender document.
9.	The stakeholders requested that the high tension lines (HT) passing through the blocks may be marked in the geological map of actionable block.	The high tension lines etc. falling in the auction blocks are marked on the maps.
10.	The stakeholder requested that the status of industry to mining may be given in the Rajasthan State like other states.	The issue will be discussed at appropriate level by Department and action will be taken accordingly.
11.	The stakeholder requested that the resources are being calculated at 100% core recovery in blocks of Nagaur district, the resources may calculated as per the core recovery.	The core recovery may be less due to mechanical reasons. The core recovery is more than 95% in the adjoining area where drilling has been carried out through outsourcing.
12.	The stakeholder requested that the reserve price of the blocks put up for auction may be kept around 4 to 5% like other states.	The reserve price in State of Rajasthan has been fixed after various discussion and deliberations. It has been fixed on the basis of additional amount a govt. company has to pay in addition to royalty, NMET and DMFT.

6. DMG Rajasthan conveyed to the stakeholders that a Rajasthan Summit is scheduled in the month of January and all the stakeholders are requested for active participation in it. The company interested in investing in mining sector in the state of Rajasthan are requested to submit detailed proposal to DMG Rajasthan at the earliest.
